## Brain Storm....

Title: Acute gastric dilatation leading to ischemic necrosis- a rare post-operative complication following sigmoid volvulus resection.

### Introduction:

Sigmoid volvulus occurs when twisting of sigmoid colon about its mesentery, causing closed loop obstruction which maybe partial or complete. Acute gastric dilatation is a post-operative complication of major laparotomies which can progress to ischemia of stomach, is an under-diagnosed condition and is disastrous if not intervened early.

### Case summary:

25 year old male presented to the casualty with one day history of dull aching abdominal pain, predominantly in lower part associated with abdominal distension and obstipation. He had history of loose stools for the past 1 month, treated with Mesalamine for possible inflammatory bowel disease but patient didn't have melena. On examination, abdomen was distended but, non-tender with mild guarding and no bowel sounds heard. Per rectal examination showed mucoid staining without any blood or melena. X-ray revealed hugely dilated colon and CECT showed sigmoid volvulus with non-enhancing bowel wall. Patient was posted for laparotomy and Sigmoid volvulus was resected, distal sigmoid and descending colon anastomosis was done with covering ileostomy. Stoma started functioning on the post-operative day (POD)-1. Ryle's Tube was removed and the patient was started on oral fluid and tolerated well. Patient developed abdominal distension with pain on POD-2. The patient was kept nil per oral due to abdominal pain.



## Cont.....

The patient developed tachycardia, hypotension on POD-3 and on RT insertion, 2 liters of bilious fluid was drained. Repeat X-ray showed dilated stomach and few dilated bowel loops. Patient developed further abdominal distension with febrile spikes on the evening of POD 3 and was posted for re-exploration suspecting anastomotic site leak.




Figure 2: Intra-operative picture of Sigmoid Volvulus.

On re-exploration, 50 ml turbid fluid was present with small intestine dilated for 200 cm from Duodeno-jejunal flexure but, anastomotic site was patent. The stomach showed two gangrenous patches – 4x5 cm on the anterior wall and 6x5 cm on the posterior wall with impending perforation. Distal gastrectomy and gastro-jejunostomy was done. Patient developed severe metabolic acidosis and hypotension in the immediate postoperative period and was started on inotropic support. However, inspite of best resuscitative efforts the patient could not be salvaged and succumbed to sepsis 6 hours post-operatively.

## Discussion/Conclusion:

As per literature, acute gastric dilatation can result due to eating disorders, electrolyte disturbances and multiple other conditions. Reported mortality rate of gastric ischemia and perforation due to dilatation is 80% to 100%. Acute gastric dilatation produces vague symptoms initially. Vomiting occurs in more than 90% cases. Progressive abdominal distension with pain occurs mostly but might be too mild to be noticed initially. Imaging and watchful monitoring is the key factor in diagnosis. Early diagnosis and decompression improves prognosis though delayed perforation or bleeding might happen even after decompression. Acute gastric dilatation should be watched out for after any major laparotomy and RT to be placed to prevent this fatal complication.

## Consent for Publication:

## CASE REPORT: A rare case of perforation of Meckel's diverticulum in an infant

### INTRODUCTION

Meckel's diverticulum is a persistent remnant of the vitellointestinal duct which measures 5cm approximately and occurs about 45-60cm from the ileocecal valve.

Male:female = 1:1

It is a true diverticulum containing either gastric mucosa(50%), pancreatic mucosa(5%) or colonic mucosa.

Clinical presentation are: lower GI bleeding(most common), diverticulitis, intussusception, chronic ulceration, intestinal obstruction, perforation.

Pre-operative diagnosis is difficult as there is no specific investigation available.

99m Technicium pertechnate scan is available at certain centre for diagnosis with 85% sensitivity and 95% specificity.





## Case report :

A 9 month old male infant presented to the casualty with history of refusal of feeds and crying continuously for two days.

On examination, the child had abdominal distension with diffuse tenderness over all quadrants of the abdomen.

On further evaluation, ultrasonography of the abdomen and pelvis showed mild fluid in the peritoneal cavity with internal echoes with features suggestive of pneumoperitoneum. Erect x ray abdomen showed air under diaphragm. Total cell counts were increased with predominantly neutrophils.

Infant was resuscitated and underwent Emergency Exploratory Laparotomy. Perforation of the Meckel's Diverticulum at the base along with peritonitis was identified.

Resection of the Meckel's Diverticulum along with 5cm of ileum on either sides was done , followed by end to end anastomosis of the ileum .

Post operative period was uneventful.

Child was monitored closely and was discharged on post operative day-6.

The child was reviewed after 15 days in OPD and followed upto three months.

## Discussion

Meckel's diverticulum is the most common congenital anomaly of the small bowel.

It can present as symptomatic Meckel's diverticulum or as an incidental finding per- operatively.

There is no specific investigation of choice for the diagnosis of Meckel's diverticulum.

Treatment of symptomatic Meckel's diverticulum is either diverticulectomy or segmental resection of the ileum which depends upon the pathology.

Conservative approach is supported for incidental Meckel's diverticulum.

However studies have shown the incidence of malignancy in Meckel's diverticulum to be 1.44 per 10 million.

Hence the decision for surgical resection of Meckel's diverticulum is made on a personalised basis weighing risk and benefits of age, complications and malignancy

## CONCLUSION :

Perforation of the Meckel's diverticulum is a rare complication ,difficult to diagnose pre-operatively. The incidence of Meckel's diverticulum is common among children less than 2 years of age.Spontaneous perforation of the Meckel's diverticulum can present as acute abdomen.Early diagnosis and timely intervention is essential for the better outcome of the patient. Hence Meckel's diverticulum perforation has to be considered among one of the differential diagnosis in case of acute onset pain abdomen among the infants.
