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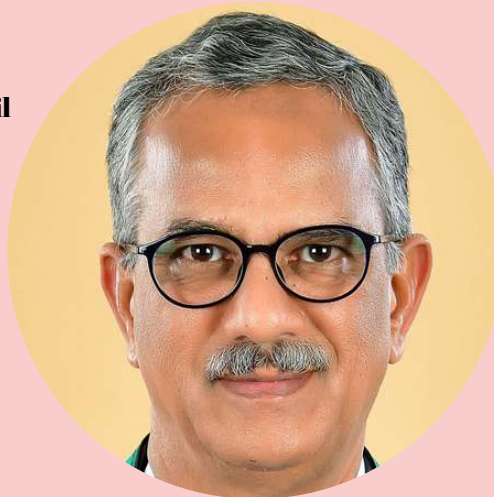
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From Chairman's Desk

I am a surgeon, a teacher first, educator, and former chairman of KSC -ASI. We surgeons are leaders in our profession and society. Hardwork, dedication and determination and defining goals are the key for success. I can firmly say these key soft skills I could achieve from my mother Late Smt. Kallya Jaya Devaraya Shenoy .

Preamble: Post-independence, India faced several challenges such as poverty, lack of education and healthcare. All 3 affected millions of citizens of India including my mother's family. When my mother was 15-year-old, she lost her father to typhoid fever. She was the eldest of five children. Elders got her married to Kallya Devaraya Shenoy (my father) who was a clerk in Canara Bank, in 1955. It is ironic that my grandfather (mother's father) was the first Headmaster of Govt Primary School in Karkala (place I was born) but his daughter (my mother) could not study beyond 9 th class. She was brilliant, first in the class and studies, but could not continue her studies.

Home-maker to leader. My mother was perfect home maker. Took the responsibility of taking care of 5 children (my siblings) with discipline and dedication. She was very well organized and had time for everyone. It is very much surprising that with meager salary from my father, she took responsibility of taking care of all needs of we 5 siblings and home. She might not have been well educated but she was literate and well-informed. One of her many strengths was communication skills.

She could articulate well with everyone because she was up-to-date about everything. She taught us communication skills. She participated in all chess tournaments conducted in the memory of my father Late Kallya Devaraya Shenoy memorial chess tournaments. She interacted with players and parents every time.

Mothers are the unsung heroes, unpaid teachers and magical fixers:

My mother turned out to be a great mother in law to my wife, not only sparing her any cooking or household work, but also strongly supported her in every way while she was doing postgraduation in anaesthesia in KMC Manipal, dept which is extremely busy. When she got an opportunity to go to UK for higher studies, leaving both children (Ranjan and Rachana) at home, my mother assisted by my in-laws took care of them. Often we underestimate the role played by our elders, we take it for granted but their love and support are like a big banyan tree beneath which we can rest safely and comfortably. We realise this only when such supports are not available.



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Smt Kallya Jaya Devaraya Shenoy – My mother

My mother was a very social person. She had many, many friends and she could nurture and maintain all of those friendships well. Joining any non-government organization gives us opportunity to talk to different people, to understand each other, to appreciate everyone's actions, service and their work. She was familiar with Lions club (I am a Lions club member). In addition, she also got exposed to Rotary club, Mahila Samaj etc. She was very fondly called as Amma by some and Jayamma by others. All that she did was talk to people, like their activities, encourage them and share their enjoyment. She gave financial help for girls from economically backward sections, for education purposes. She celebrated life! She was generous too. She was an epitome of love and respect. She encouraged everyone to come up in life including nonfamily members. She lived all of her 80 years to the fullest ('thumbu jeevana'). My saashtaanga pranams to this great woman, my mother, who gave me this life!

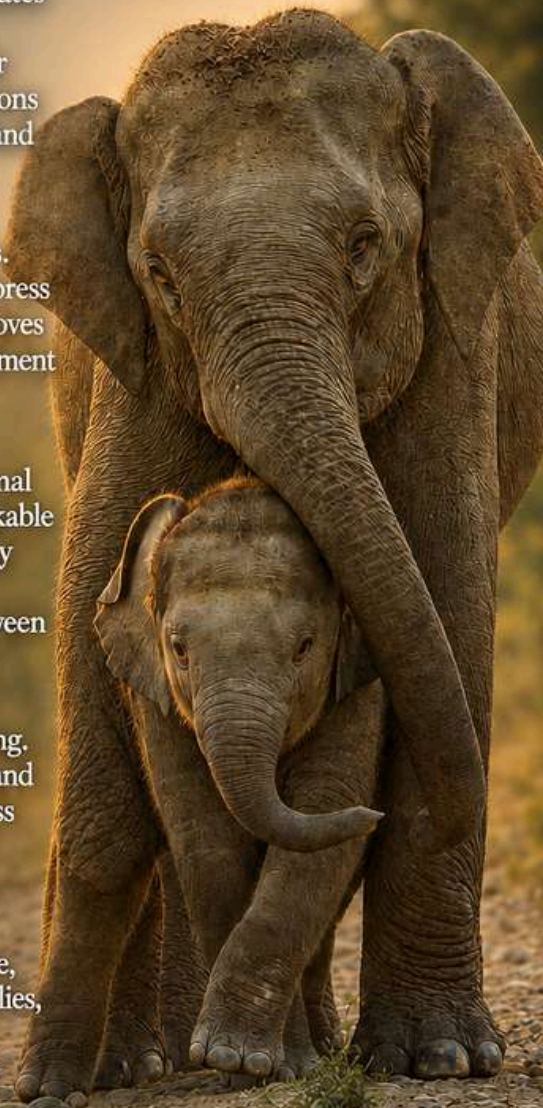
