MIDCON 2021 communication about abstracts

Dear Students,

Greetings from KSCASI.

We are writing to you to help you achieve greater heights in your academic pursuits.

The MIDCON of KSCASI to be held on 23rd, 24th and 25th September 2021, is YOUR conference.

It is designed to help you present papers and posters so that you meet your academic requirements. We join hands with your teachers to make the path smoother for you. We are keen to accept all submissions. But we have a duty to maintain minimum standards. Otherwise the credibility of the student, his institution and the association, are all at stake!

For you to have a presentation accepted ...

First of all, design and conduct a good study.

It must have a research question.

Methodology to answer that question

Data analytics with statistics to make the answer meaningful.

Give the answers as your conclusion; remember, conclusions must be supported by your data.

Give your submission in a structured abstract that is no more than 250 words long, under the following headings:

Title

Introduction - why are you doing the study?
Subjects (Materials) and methods - What are you doing?
Results - what did you find/
Conclusions.

Case reports, just listing a few operations that you have done without adequate followup, retrospective listing of cases without proper metrics defined as outcomes, do not qualify as studies to be considered as papers to be presented. These may be rejected as free papers and accepted as posters.

Not all submissions will be accepted automatically; case reports will be accepted only if it is a rare case or the intervention is unique. The abstracts for case reports will have headings similar to free papers but the content will be different:

Title

Case report - brief report with relevant investigations, intervention and outcome **Discussion** - why do you think this case is special? Are there other similar reports? Are you recommending anything new or unusual based on your experience? How would you take the issue forward?

Conclusion

An expert panel will scrutinize all submissions and decide about acceptance or otherwise.

This time the midcon is a web based event.

The papers will be for 8 mins with 2 mins for discussion.

The posters will be for 3 mins with 2 mins for discussion.

We wish you the very best. Participate in large numbers. Remember we are here to help you. Do write to us if you have any queries. <u>Submissions must be in the prescribed Google Form Only. The last day for submission of abstracts is 20th Aug 2021</u>. These deadlines will be followed strictly.

Registration to the conference and Associate/Full Membership of ASI are mandatory for submission of abstracts.
